To begin with some feedback on the AGM, 82 members including the committee and past Chairmen Bob McIntyre and Pat Walsh attended the 17th December meeting. Most stayed for a glass of wine and snack afterwards, extending the lively buzz of the evening.

Copies of WRRRA's Welcome Pack for visitors and new residents were circulated and much admired. Many issues were raised by our members during the AGM including the poor state of Waterside Road at the Eden end, cost of capital contributions, the demise of WETA—the local tourism body, as well as queries relating to the development of Destiny Africa and its effect on our area. The incoming committee will follow up on all these issues.

The existing committee was voted back in, with John Callanan and Pieter Naudé's previous co-option being formalized and the inclusion of Hugh Pharoah, creating a strong committee of 12. Sue Ledger was co-opted in to continue her concentration on persuading the authorities to move the proposed N2 bypass away from Ebb & Flow and the wetland.
