

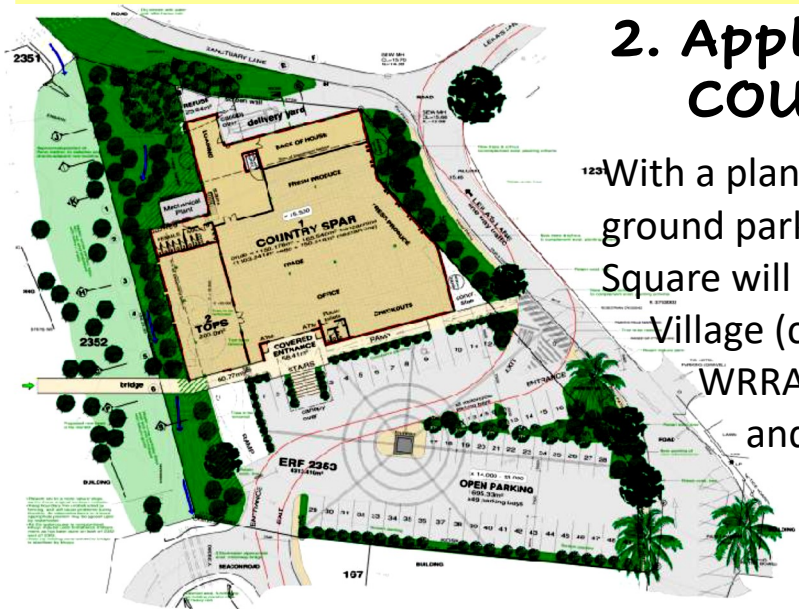

1. WATER RESTRICTIONS LIFTED!

On 15 March 2021, the Garden Route Dam (GRD) level was at 99.74% in terms of its capacity before the construction of the new spillway (approx. 80% in terms of its new capacity). This allowed for the Section 2 B Water Restrictions to be lifted with immediate effect.



2. Application in for a COUNTRY SPAR!

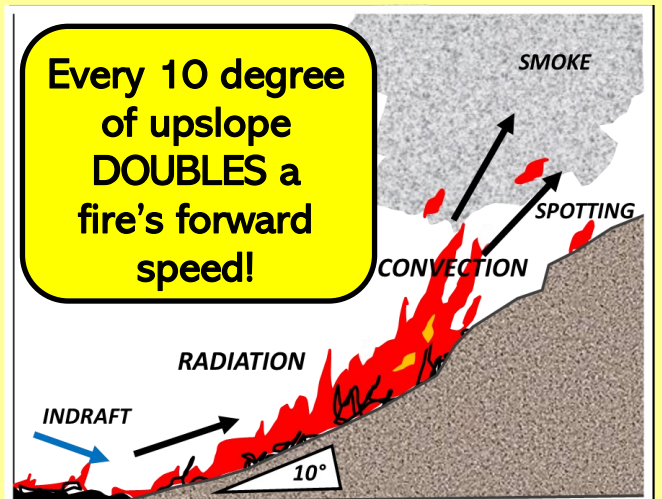
With a planned 35 underground and 49 above ground parking spaces, the proposed Wilderness Square will maximise the area east of Milkwood Village (currently the dirt parking area).

WRRRA has studied the ± 90 page proposal and issued cautions but no objections.
